

STATUS AND PLAN IN USING LAND AREA FOR DEVELOPMENT OF CROPPING SYSTEM IN BABE DISTRICT, BAC KAN PROVINCE 2006 – 2010, VIET NAM

TÓM TẮT:

Babe is the one district of Backan province in North region of Vietnam. The district is rich in land resource and area of natural forest covered most of total area. According to statistical book in 2005, used land area is 56,004.41 ha (80.84%) and the unused land area is 13,106.59ha (19.16 %)

Even though, it's economic and infrastructure conditions are still poor, population density is 68 persons/km² with more than 97 % of belong to ethnic minority groups. Up to 2010: Of the total natural area 68,421 ha, agriculture land area will be 8,084.97 ha (11.82%) increasing 1,279.36 ha and forestry land area will be 53,077.51 ha (77.59%) increasing 6,725.31 ha compare to 2006; non_agriculture land area will be 2,398.32 ha (3.51%) increasing 320.24 ha; abundant land area will 4,784.80 ha (6.99 %), reducing 8,321.79 ha compare to 2006.
